- 4 RF Step to right.
- 5 LF Step to side in LOD.
- & Step together. RF
- 6 LF Step forward.
- 7 RF Make ¼ turn left and step forward in LOD.
- & LF Step together.
- 8 RF Step forward.

### 9-16: ¼ TURN CHASSÉ, ¼ RIGHT SHUFFLE BACK, 1½ **TURN RIGHT, SHUFFLE BACK**

- 3 RFMake ¼ turn right and step side.

- 7 LF Step back.
- & RF Step together.
